

ANNOUNCEMENT OF VACANCY

The Genesee Water and Sanitation District Board of Directors has a vacancy on its 5-member board and is looking for a district resident to fill it.

Qualifications: You must be a resident or property-owning eligible elector of the District to be appointed to the Board to fill a vacancy. Your term will expire in May 2023 and at such time you may stand for election of a 2 or 4 year term.

Time Requirements: The GW&SD is a political subdivision of the State of Colorado, and you represent the voters (customers) of the District. There are 12 regular Board meeting, usually held on the 4th Tuesday of the month at 5:00 pm, except for November and December. There may also be special meetings. Meetings last for about 1.5 but can last longer if needed. Attendance can be by Zoom, but mostly in-person.

It is customary for a Board member, depending on their time and interests, to contribute his/her experience and expertise. The time commitment varies depending on the member. Additionally, the reading load to prepare for Board meetings is a few hours depending on pending issues.

Duties: As a Board member of a public entity, you have a fiduciary responsibility to act in the best interests of the District and not your personal agenda. You should be prepared for the Board meetings by reading the information provided by staff and your own research. Reading matter can be financial reports, engineering studies, contracts, legal documents, regulatory issues, and other such items.

Application: Although not required, you can send a short email (not more than 100 to 150 words) by September 16, 2022, to the Board expressing your interest and how you see contributing to the District and its customers. Email: info@geneseewater.com. You may also apply in person at the September 27th meeting where action is planned.

You must be nominated by a current board member and receive a second to your nomination by another board member.
